Financing is available to both nonadmitted students registered for courses and admitted candidates officially accepted into a program.

You are a nonadmitted student if:	You are an admitted candidate if:
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ You are registered and enrolled in courses independent of an Extension School degree or health careers program; or ◆ You are taking prerequisite courses and planning to apply to an Extension School program. <p>*See below for nonadmitted candidate financial aid information.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ You have completed the three prerequisite courses required for admission to a degree or health careers program; and ◆ You have submitted an application and been officially admitted by the Dean or program director. <p>*See reverse for admitted candidate financial aid information.</p>

Nonadmitted students may apply for a credit-based private education loan. To apply:

- ◆ Complete the loan application with the lender of your choosing.
- ◆ Submit the Request for Private Loan Certification form, available on our website.

Nonadmitted students may also be eligible to apply for the following scholarships. (See our website for eligibility and application criteria.)

- ◆ Phi Theta Kappa (PTK) Scholarships for community college graduates who wish to join the Bachelor of Liberal Arts (ALB) program
- ◆ Lowell Scholarships for Boston-area middle and high school teachers and high school students
- ◆ Community Scholarships for Cambridge high school students, Cambridge city employees, and Allston-Brighton residents

Please note, to be considered for federal, state, or institutional aid, you must:

- ✓ Be officially admitted to a degree or health careers program
- ✓ Be a US citizen or eligible noncitizen and have a valid Social Security number
- ✓ Maintain satisfactory academic progress
- ✓ Be in good academic and financial standing with Harvard's Division of Continuing Education
- ✓ Be enrolled for the minimum number of credits specified by each applicable loan or grant
- ✓ Be registered with the Selective Service, if required
- ✓ Not be in default on any federal student loans or owe money on any federal student grants
- ✓ Not be receiving financial aid from another school for the same term

To apply for financial aid, complete the following two forms by the priority deadlines:

- ◆ Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), available at www.fafsa.ed.gov
- ◆ Enrollment Plan for Financial Aid form, available on our website, www.extension.harvard.edu
